2026/0055/FULL – Demolition of 2 No existing agricultural buildings. Construction of new stable block for non-commercial use – **Panthers Lodge, Brington Road, Long Buckby**

2026/0445/TCA - T1, T2, T3 and T4 are a small group of 3 x semi mature sycamore trees and 1 x ash tree - 1-2m overall crown reduction back to suitable growth points, G1 is a group of semi mature self-set sycamore and ash trees - works to coppice the group down to just above ground level - **Holloway House, 21 Harbidges Lane, Long Buckby**
